2. Closing date for this sale is Tue., April 20, 2010 at 5:00 P.M. (EDT). Email and FAX bids will also be accepted until that time. Tie bids will be awarded to the earliest bid received. Bids received after the closing time will not be honored.
3. Bidders who are unknown to us are requested to supply two trade references prior to the sale or submit a deposit equal to twenty-five percent (25%) of their total bid.
4. A fifteen percent (15%) Buyer's Fee will be added to each lot won. **A packing charge of seventy-five cents per lot (minimum \$3.00) plus shipping charges will be added.**
